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EMERGENCY TROUBLES FACING THE CHILDREN

As set forth herein, this emergency arises from the ongoing and unlawful kidnapping of three minor children, two of whom are autistic and especially vulnerable.

The children were forcefully abducted from their home and have been held in violation of valid court orders, laws and statutes as set forth herein, deprived of their father—who was their full custodial and decision-making parent—until his tragic death while desperately trying to rescue them.

The defendants’ continued restraint of these children is not only a grave threat to their safety and well-being, but also a direct violation of both federal and Arizona law. **Under 18 U.S.C. § 1201 (federal kidnapping statute) and A.R.S. § 13-1304 (Arizona kidnapping statute), kidnapping is a continuing offense: every moment the children remain unlawfully detained constitutes a new and ongoing violation.**

The law does not permit any **grace period or delay** in ending such restraint. The statutes are clear—the obligation to release kidnapped victims is immediate and absolute.

The fact that these children have been held for nearly two years only intensifies the urgency; the passage of time does not lessen the emergency but rather compounds the harm and the legal violations. False imprisonment for even one second is a grave civil rights violation, and continued detention is a direct affront to **their constitutional rights to liberty and due process under the Fourteenth Amendment.**

Therefore, Plaintiffs respectfully urge this Court to recognize that the law requires **the children’s immediate release**, without further delay. No judicial or law enforcement inaction can justify the continued deprivation of these children’s liberty and safety for another second.

The **emergency** remains as acute today as it was on the day of their abduction, and the Court’s intervention is both justified and required to halt the ongoing crime and

1 restore the children's rights.

- 2 • United States v. Rodriguez-Moreno, 526 U.S. 275 (1999):
 - 3 ○ The Supreme Court held that kidnapping is a continuing offense, and
 - 4 venue is proper in any district where the offense continued. This
 - 5 supports the argument that the crime is ongoing as long as the children

 - 10 offense is complete. Kidnapping is recognized as such a continuing

12 I. INTRODUCTION

13 While the Children's Best Interest is paramount and in line with "The Interests of

14 Justice", the Plaintiffs request of a criminal referral is to seek only for the appropriate

15 investigation and prosecution, not a determination of guilt by the civil court.

16 Plaintiffs, Reverend John W. Stone and Shirley D. Stone, respectfully move this Court,

17 pursuant to Rule 65 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, for an emergency order directing

18 the immediate rescue and release of their three minor grandchildren who are children of their

19 son and decedent, Timothy Paul Stone, from the ongoing unlawful detention and

20 endangerment by Defendants Brittany Houston, Sarea Laron McCree, and Heiress Dupree.

21 Police Reports and Investigations from January 9, 2024, January 15, 2024, January 29,

22 2024, and four separate Court Orders, as set forth herein, confirm the fact that the children

23 were unlawfully taken from their home and were never returned which caused the sudden

24 death of their full custodial parent and father 54 days later and on March 2, 2024.

25 The kidnapping of a child is widely considered a severe form of **child abuse**, neglect and

26 endangerment and is specifically **emotional and psychological abuse**, due to the profound

trauma and harm inflicted on the minor children.

1 **The Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act (CAPTA)**, for instance, defines child
2 abuse as any act or failure to act that results in "death, serious physical or emotional harm,
3 sexual abuse or exploitation, or an act or failure to act that presents an imminent risk of serious
4 harm".

5 On January 9, 2024, the children were abducted by the non-relative defendant and
6 disgruntled live-in babysitter Brittany Houston, who had just been released on bond from jail
7 for crimes against her own minor children.

8 Houston is the best friend too and co-defendant with the children's estranged mother,
9 Sarea Laron McCree. Houston transported the children in a stolen car and turned them over to
10 McCree and her felon sister Heiress Dupree who were both listed as dangerous defendants on
11 valid court orders and prohibited from being near the children and decedent.

12 **This is about continuing High-Crimes of obstruction of justice, kidnapping, major**
13 **custodial interference, Child, Vulnerable Adult, and Elder Abuse, and other crimes that**
14 **caused the torturous death of the children's father while he was trying desperately to rescue**
15 **the children, as set forth herein and throughout this motion and the Wrongful Death and Civil**
16 **Rights Complaint filed with this Court on November 7, 2025, that caused a torturous death.**

17 Pursuant to **A.R.S. §§ 13-1304 and 13-1302**, the kidnapping of three minor children, two
18 of whom are special needs, occurred on January 9, 2024, and remains ongoing.

19 The continuing offense doctrine applies as long as the children are unlawfully detained,
20 the kidnapping continues as a matter of law under both Arizona and federal statutes, including
21 **18 U.S.C. §§ 1201 and 3237(a)**.

22 The children were abducted from their home in El Mirage, Arizona, transported to and
23 concealed in Mesa, Arizona, and then moved to Nevada.

24 **The continuation of both civil and human rights violations and deprivations is at hand.**
25 False imprisonment for even one second is a grave civil rights violation. The children's ongoing
26 detention is a direct violation of their constitutional rights to liberty and due process under the
Fourteenth Amendment:

"No State shall... deprive any person of life, liberty, or property, without due process of
law; nor deny to any person within its jurisdiction the equal protection of the laws."

1 The fact that the children have been held by their kidnappers for nearly two years
2 makes this motion urgent. No judicial or law enforcement inaction can justify the continued
3 deprivation of these children’s liberty and safety for another second.

4 I. Plaintiffs respectfully request that the Court waive the requirement of security under Rule
5 65(c), or in the alternative, set the bond at a nominal amount, due to the urgent need to
6 protect the minor children, the public interest at stake, and Plaintiffs’ limited financial
7 resources. **Waiver or Reduction of Bond under Rule 65(c)**

8 • **Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(c):**

- 9 ○ **The rule allows courts discretion to waive or set a nominal bond,**
10 **especially in cases involving public interest or indigent parties.**

12 • **Waiver of Bond in Public Interest Cases:**

16 There is no dispute that on January 9, 2024, the children were abducted by the
17 defendant and disgruntled live-in babysitter Brittany Houston, who had just been released on
18 bond from jail for crimes against her own minor children.

21 **II. BACKGROUND**

22 The Furtherance of this Miscarriage of Justice and the unlawful acts being levied against the

23 Children and the Plaintiffs makes it imperative that this Court read this entire motion and the

24 complaint in the interest of justice.

25 Plaintiffs incorporate by reference the factual averments set forth in the Complaint (**see**

26 **Complaint filed with this Court on November 7, 2025**). The following facts are supported by

the attached exhibits.

1 **STEPS THAT LED TO THE KIDNAPPING**

2 On **March 22, 2023**, defendant Sarea Laron McCree, the children’s mother, who had
3 been separated from the decedent since December 19, 2022, elected to violate **A.R.S. §§ 8-531,**
4 **8-201, and 13-3623**, when she Abandoned the children, took the decedent’s family car, and fled
5 to **Las Vegas, Nevada**, to live with her sister, **Defendant Heiress Dupree**.

- 6
- 7 1. On **April 5, 2023**, during a telephonic phone-call between the decedent McCree and
8 Dupree threatened to kidnap the children and harm the decedent if he persisted in
9 seeking support and his car returned.
 - 10 2. On **April 6, 2023**, fearing for his children’s safety, the decedent filed for a **protection**
11 **order** with El Mirage AZ Municipal Court **Judge Michael Parascandola**.
 - 12 3. Judge Parascandola found credible threats of kidnapping and abuse by McCree and
13 Dupree and issued **protection orders** listing the decedent and children as plaintiffs, and
14 McCree and Dupree as defendants. **See Exhibits 1 and 2, Protection Orders against**
15 **McCree and Dupree respectively.**
 - 16 4. **Clark County, NV Deputy Sheriff Robert Wyant** was successful in serving defendant
17 **Dupree** but after talking to her roommate and sister, defendant McCree, and
18 attempting to serve her on four different occasions he lodged an affidavit complaining
19 that McCree was intentionally evading service. **See Exhibit 3a, Affidavit of Deputy**
20 **Sheriff Wyant for serving defendant Dupree on April 19, 2024, and See Exhibit 3b, the**
21 **April 21, 2023, Affidavit of Deputy Sheriff Wyant evincing his conversation with McCree**
22 **and his four attempts to serve her the protection order.**
 - 23 5. In **April 2023**, **Defendant Brittany Houston** (defendant McCree’s best friend) moved in
24 with the decedent, claiming she needed help, and she would help him with his children.
 - 25 6. The decedent made Houston aware of the Protection Order against defendants McCree
26 and Dupree, and copies of the orders were made available to her and kept in the
decedent’s vehicle and apartment.
 7. On **May 1, 2023**, **Judge Melissa Zabor** issued a **Paternity Order** stipulating that if either
parent was absent for six months, the other would have full decision-making for the

1 children. **See Exhibit 4 and Maricopa County Superior Court Case No: [FC2023-001201,**
2 **The Stipulation as to Paternity Order].**

3 8. On December 6, 2023, defendant and lead kidnapper Brittany Houston, the children's non-
4 relative live-in babysitter, was arrested for aggravated assault against a minor child and a
5 Surprise Elementary School Faculty member by the El Mirage, AZ Police.

6 9. On December 6, 2023, after the arrest of Houston, the police found 8 bench warrants
7 against Houston for crimes against her own minor children. **See Exhibit 5, a list of the 8**
8 **charges in the City of Phoenix Municipal Court Case Number: 5774496.**

9 10. On December 7, 2023, Houston's mother bailed her out of jail.

10 11. On January 2, 2024, in an effort to have Houston removed from his home for
11 abusing the children and himself, the decedent took his children with him to the El Mirage
12 Municipal Court and petitioned the court for a Protection Order to protect him and his
13 children against Houston. However, at that time defendant Judge Parascandola denied the
14 petition.

15 12. On **January 3, 2024**, the decedent's insulin disappeared; on **January 5**, Houston found it,
16 but it appeared tampered with.

17 13. On **January 9, 2024**, the decedent, believing Houston had poisoned him, was rushed to
18 **Boswell Hospital ICU.**

19 14. On January 9, 2024, Houston appeared angry at the hospital, refused to return the
20 decedent's car keys, threatened him, and stole his car from the hospital parking lot.

21 15. On January 9, 2024, around 4:30 P.M., upon returning home, the decedent found his
22 three children missing. Houston refused to cooperate; the decedent called **911.**

23 16. On **January 9, 2024**, **Defendant Officer Matt Jacobs** and other El Mirage Police
24 responded. The decedent made it crystal clear that Houston had no permission to give
25 the children to anyone, especially McCree or Dupree.

26 17. On January 9, 2024, and thereafter, despite knowing the decedent's vulnerable and
protected class status, the First Responders Duties and Mandatory Statutes and Laws
including, **A.R.S. §§ 8-901, 8-810, 13-3623, and 13-3620**, the existence of protection

1 orders and the danger the children were in, the police **failed to locate or rescue the**
2 **children.**

3 18. Although there were valid court orders in place to prevent the kidnapping and wrongful
4 acts of law enforcement for not recovering the children, in the state of Arizona, there
5 need not even be a court order in place for a charge of kidnapping to be charged.

6 19. The fact is that the children were unlawfully taken with the intent to deprive them of their
7 father and the father, the decedent, of his children, and not returned prior to or after the
8 torturous death of the decedent.

9 **IV. STATEMENT OF FACTS**

10 **Intent and Facilitation by Officials, CubeSmart, and MetLife**

11 The record establishes that the named officials, CubeSmart, and MetLife were
12 repeatedly notified of the ongoing kidnapping, imminent danger to the children, and the
13 escalating risk to Timothy Paul Stone, yet failed to take meaningful action to intervene
14 or enforce protection orders. This deliberate indifference, coupled with affirmative acts
15 such as obstructing justice, manipulating judicial proceedings, and refusing to rescue the
16 children, constitutes a “state-created danger” under federal law (see *DeShaney v.*
17 *Winnebago County, 489 U.S. 189 (1989); Kennedy v. City of Ridgefield, 439 F.3d 1055*
18 *(9th Cir. 2006)*). The officials’ willful disregard for the plaintiffs’ urgent pleas, their
19 failure to enforce valid court orders, and their active discouragement of self-rescue
20 efforts directly facilitated the continued kidnapping and contributed to the decedent’s
21 torturous death. CubeSmart’s role as the location where the children were concealed,
22 despite knowledge of court orders and police reports, and MetLife’s refusal to act on
23 overwhelming evidence of beneficiary fraud, furthered the conspiracy to deprive the
24 plaintiffs and decedent of their constitutional rights under 42 U.S.C. §§ 1983 and 1985.
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Points and Authorities Supporting Intent and Cover-Up

The facts alleged support a finding of intent to promote or facilitate the ongoing kidnapping and cover-up, as the defendants’ actions and omissions were not merely negligent but part of a coordinated scheme. **Under *Adickes v. S.H. Kress & Co.*, 398 U.S. 144 (1970), a conspiracy under § 1985** may be inferred from circumstantial evidence of agreement and overt acts in furtherance of the unlawful objective. Here, the officials’ repeated failure to act, CubeSmart’s provision of a safe haven for the abducted children despite knowledge of court orders, and MetLife’s refusal to disqualify a beneficiary implicated in the wrongful death, all constitute overt acts furthering the conspiracy.

The manipulation of judicial proceedings, obstruction of criminal referrals, and encouragement of concealment by judicial officers (**see *Dennis v. Sparks*, 449 U.S. 24 (1980)**) demonstrate a pattern of conduct designed to perpetuate the kidnapping, shield the perpetrators, and deny the plaintiffs due process and equal protection. These acts, taken together, establish not only intent but also actionable facilitation and cover-up under **federal civil rights statutes and Arizona law.**

1. Plaintiffs are the biological grandparents of the minor children and the parents of the decedent, Timothy Paul Stone.
2. The children were kidnapped on January 9, 2024, by non-relative and live-in babysitter Defendant Brittany Houston, with the assistance of Defendants Sarea Laron McCree and Heiress Dupree, and have been unlawfully detained since that date.
3. The children are subject to valid protection orders issued by Judge Michael Parascandola, which prohibited Defendants McCree, Dupree, and Houston from contact with the children.
4. Law enforcement and judicial officials have been repeatedly notified of the ongoing danger and have failed to act to rescue the children.
5. The children remain in unlawful custody and face ongoing risk of physical and emotional

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harm, and their continued detention constitutes irreparable injury.

6. Plaintiffs have standing to seek this relief as next friends and as parties to this action, and the children’s interests are directly aligned with the relief sought.

Key facts establishing crimes and ongoing violations:

- On January 9, 2024, pursuant to the law, and court orders as set forth herein, the decedent, the children’s full custodial and decision-making parent, called 911 and reported his children missing, which automatically made A.R.S. §§ 8-810, 8-901, 13-3620, 13-3623 and other laws.
- On January 10, 2024, in a continued effort to rescue his children and protect them and himself against Houston, the decedent petitioned the El Mirage Municipal Court for a Protection Order to protect himself and the children and it was granted. See Exhibit 6, Protection Order against Houston.
- The children were taken without his consent, and for 54 days were concealed from him, in violation of multiple valid court orders.
- The intent of the kidnappers was to deprive the children of their father and the father of his children, causing him severe emotional distress and contributing to his death.
- The children’s continued detention is a continuing offense under 18 U.S.C. § 3237(a) and Arizona law, and is supported by case law (e.g., McNamara v. State, Nevada).
- On **January 15, 2024**, the decedent and plaintiff contacted El Mirage Police for updates. Officers confirmed the legitimacy of the protection orders and acknowledged the danger posed by the defendants but **advised against self-rescue.**
- On **January 25, 2024**, the decedent and plaintiff filed an **Urgent Criminal Complaint** with **Governor Katie Hobbs** and **Attorney General Kristin Mayes** regarding police misconduct and the children’s danger. See Exhibit 7, January 25, 2024, Certified Criminal Complaint.
- On **January 29, 2024**, Governor Hobbs and Police Chief Marzocca responded, but Marzocca claimed the decedent was incapacitated when the children were taken and refused to intervene further.

- 1 • On **February 1, 2024**, under extreme stress, the decedent threatened McCree if she did
2 not return the children. McCree called **911; Mesa Police Officer Damian Ryden**
3 threatened the decedent with harm if he tried to get the children.
- 4 • On **February 21, 2024**, **Hot Shots Process Service** served McCree with the protection
5 order at **CubeSmart Storage Facility** in Mesa, but she ignored it and kept the children.
- 6 • On February 29, 2024, in a continued effort to rescue his children the decedent filed an
7 Emergency Motion with the Court. **See Exhibit 8, Decedent’s Emergency Motion.**
- 8 • On **March 2, 2024**, the plaintiffs were notified that the decedent was found deceased in
9 his apartment.
- 10 • On **March 4, 2024**, at a hearing, Judge Parascandola acknowledged the alleged
11 violations of the protection order by defendant McCree, and he refused to protect the
12 children who were still the petitioning plaintiffs listed on the Protection Order.
- 13 • On March 4, 2024, Judge Parascandola told the plaintiffs that he did not have the
14 jurisdiction to hear and rule on the felonies alleged to have been committed by
15 defendant McCree and he referred the plaintiffs to the Superior Court and Law
16 Enforcement. Judge Parascandola also ignored the decedent’s Emergency Motion and
17 denied the plaintiffs the opportunity to present evidence of ongoing danger to the
18 children.

18 **IV. LEGAL STANDARD**

19 A preliminary injunction is warranted where the movant demonstrates:

- 20 1. A likelihood of success on the merits,
21 2. A likelihood of irreparable harm in the absence of preliminary relief,
22 3. That the balance of equities tips in the movant’s favor, and
23 4. That an injunction is in the public interest.

24 See *Winter v. Natural Resources Defense Council, Inc.*, 555 U.S. 7, 20 (2008).

25 The Ninth Circuit also recognizes a sliding scale approach, where a strong showing of
26 one factor may offset a weaker showing of another.

1 **V. ARGUMENT**

2 **A. The Kidnapping Is a Continuing Crime and a Constitutional Violation**

3 The facts establish that the children were kidnapped and remain unlawfully detained.
4 Under the continuing offense doctrine, crimes are ongoing until the children are released. The
5 children’s continued detention is a direct violation of their constitutional rights to liberty and
6 due process under the Fourteenth Amendment, and their right to petition the government
7 under the First Amendment.

8 **B. Irreparable Harm and Public Interest**

9 The children are at ongoing risk of physical and emotional harm. Monetary damages
10 cannot remedy the loss of safety, liberty, or well-being. The equities overwhelmingly favor the
11 children’s immediate safety and protection from further harm. The public interest is served by
12 enforcing court orders, protecting vulnerable children, and upholding the rule of law.

24 **C. Judicial and Law Enforcement Inaction Does Not Excuse Ongoing Violation**

25 No action or inaction by law enforcement or the judiciary can justify the continued
26 deprivation of the children’s liberty. The Court has both the authority and the duty to intervene
to prevent furtherance of a miscarriage of justice.

03/22/2023 Sarea stole my car Ford Escape 2018 license plate number DNA 7ME and fled the state to move to Las Vegas to avoid divorce proceedings and pretty much stopped communicating with me. Also April 5th, 2023 Sarea also had her mother call me and Sister call me making threats about physically assaulting me and taking kids. The Kid piece was on the sister. Sarea also still has my car even though were married she cannot renew plates and the mom also threatened to destroy the car
04/05/2023 I texted sarea to give my car back on Sunday because of multiple reasons about infidelity, mental capacity, not being able to pay for car and more. She had no response but then allowed her mom and sister to call me and tell me they would come here kidnap my kids which sarea left with me because she is incapable of caring for them and told CPS in Arizona that they would be better with me. She allowed her mom and sister to threaten me and I have the text messages that show it.

06/11/2022 police report # 22-29058. Sarea and John (my father) both called 911 as Sarea again was yelling and cussing me out she then proceeded to hit me multiple times and scratched me twice as I got out the shower naked. I grabbed her arms for her to say I was choking her which is when she called police both my mom and dad were witnesses to this and the police came and let her take kids and leave though they did recommend her to be charged for assault as I got a victim's letter the prosecutors never decided to charge her.

11/05/2022 During a minor argument with Sarea she decided to tell me and kids that she was sorry she wasn't strong enough and that she was going to kill herself. She left for a couple hours on foot but decided to come home.

11/08/2022 Sarea started an argument with me and then proceeded to pop all 25 plus pills of depression meds she had in her prescription bottle in front of me Winston my oldest and Marcel our youngest child saying she will no longer be here. She left house and within 10 minutes I called the cops and told them she is committing suicide she also threw the pill bottle at my head as she walked out, though I was trying to stop her. She did all this and when cops came they found out she spit pills out and did it to hurt me in front of kids.

11/14/2022 After having another minor argument Sarea took 20 plus anti-depressant pills in an attempt to commit suicide and called 911. They then transported her to hospital where she stayed over night and was then transported to St Lukes Behavioral Health center for a week missing Winston's birthday.

11/14/2022 Sarea tried to kill herself in the house around the kids and then left and called the police and was moved into a care facility for a week to recover and missed Winston's birthday.

12/11/2022 Sarea was yelling throughout the house non stop for over 8 hours being verbally abusive and cussing while saying many derogatory terms at me in front of the kids. I then took Winston outside to talk to him and ask if it bothered him and he said yeah I then explained that Sarea (his mom) is not mentally well and that she won't listen to me, but that he can go head and tell her it is hurting his feelings. He then went into the house shaking as he went up to her to tell her that she is hurting his feelings for her to tell him she would stop for him. After 5 minutes she than begin yelling again in the same manner this started around 10am and continued until 8pm. She verbally abused me and kids.

12/17/2022 This is an everyday thing. Marcel is a 2 year old baby that is breastfed while Sarea (mom) is a heavy weed smoker. Sometimes she will even take him out back and smoke a blunt while he is feeding on her.

12/18/2022 Me and Sarea had relations this night as it seemed to be a good day for her. After it was done she randomly left the house without saying anything slamming the door extremely loud late at night as kids were sleep. We started texting and arguing via text messages upon her return I blocked her in my phone for her to then come into my room (we slept in separate rooms) while on the phone with her friend and started to verbally abuse me as I was trying to sleep to get rest for work. She was extremely loud with the kids asleep this caused Timothy JR. to wake up and come into her room to lay down with his baby brother. She then went and smoked weed and then came back into room after I locked door to try to sleep and continued the verbal abuse with yelling which woke Winston up. She then continued to yell and stood in the doorway to my bedroom I then got up after asking her to leave my room 3 times and just touched her with 2 fingers not even a nudged to ask her to leave and then

she started to slap me I then put my arms around her shoulders for her to tell her friend on phone screaming that I was choking her and hitting her again waking the kids up more. During me holding her her bluetooth headphones fell down and she said they were broke. I then went out to tell her to please be quiet in the living room and grabbed the headphones to look if they were broken and she then continued to verbally and physically abuse me causing me to throw the headphones down again shattering them. 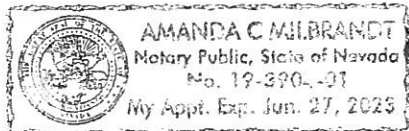

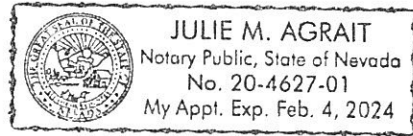



Timothy Jr. and Marcel are 10 and 3 years-old respectively, and
both are Autistic.

At the time of the disappearance Timothy's babysitter Brittany
Houston forced the Children to leave the residence and placed
them in Tim's car and transported them to an unknown location.

Brittany Houston was well aware of the following facts: She was
not authorized to use Timothy's car to transport his Children
or to remove them from the residence; She was aware of the fact
that the Children's Mother, Sarea McCree, had abandoned the

Children on March 22, 2023, and fled to Las Vegas, NV with plans to never return; She read the Protective Order issued by the El Mirage Court on April 6, 2023, against Sarea McCree, and that the Las Vegas Police made 2-attempts to serve her the protective order which she evaded; and she knew and knows of Sarea McCree's numerous visits to psychiatric wards for saying, among other admissions, that she wanted to kill herself and leave her Children.

As set-forth in AZ State and Federal Law, and other Points and Authorities, a person can be charged with the crime of custodial interference even before there is a Court Order regarding legal decision making and parenting time if she, Sarea McCree, takes, entices (persuades) or withholds any child from the other parent and denies that parent access to any child. El Mirage police refused to serve the protective order.

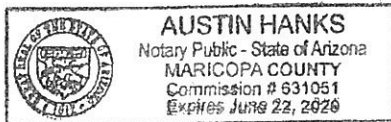

THIS EMERGENCY MOTION FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS COURT IS SUPPORTED BY THE FACT THAT THE DEFENDANT IS CURRENTLY IN GROSS VIOLATION OF THIS COURT'S ORDER AND REQUESTS A FAVORABLE RULING WHILE IN VIOLATION. DEFENDANT IS CURRENTLY UNLAWFULLY HOLDING THE CHILDREN AND REFUSES TO RELEASE THEM AS THIS COURT HAS ORDERED HER TO.

On April 6, 2023 this Court issued the Protective Order in Case NO: M0759P02023000017.

On February 21, 2024, the Protective Order was served upon the Defendant

Pursuant to ARS 13-3602, ARS 13-2810(A) 2, Contempt and Interfering with judicial proceedings, the defendant, 6-days prior to requesting a hearing, elected to disregard and violate this Court's Order, defendant continues to disregard this Court's Authority to this day.

This Court's Protective Order clearly sets-forth the fact that the defendant was NOT to come near the Children. It does not matter whether or not the protective order was served on her. It is case book law that she is committing Custodial Interference. The fact that she took custody of the Children on January 9, 2024, and has since blocked the plaintiff's access to the Children is a major violation of ARS 13-1302.

The defendant herself gives this Court a compelling reason to continue the order as is and to arrest her "willful" conduct. At the time scheduled for this hearing the defendant will be in gross violation of the order for 12-days. However, her evading and resistance to this Court's order began in Las Vegas, NV in April and May of 2023.

The defendant has displayed to this Court that She is subject to disregard any Order this Court issues. The defendant has also shown that she will abandon her Children whenever she feels like it. She believes there should be NO consequences for Emotionally abusing her Children.

The defendant knows that 2 of her Children are autistic. The defendant's acts against her Children are "Cold-Blooded". The plaintiff has evidence where the defendant made sure the Children were watching her attempt suicide on 2-separate occasions, the a few months later abandoning the family when she fled to Las Vegas, NV. The defendant could of come back to Arizona at anytime to challenge this Court's order but she elected to stay in Las Vegas.

The mere fact that the defendant waited 6-days after being, officially, served to request a hearing shows that she was and is willing to have her Children experience the sight of seeing her get arrested and possibly themselves being detained by law enforcement and or Welfare personnel until the Plaintiff can be contacted. To prevent that all she had to do is obey this Court's order by getting the Children to the plaintiff and then request a hearing, but she didn't.

The plaintiff is asking this Court to read the Certified Criminal Complaint and Addendum to the Certified Criminal Complaint, that are attached to this pleading as Exhibit 1 and Exhibit 2. The exhibits are tied directly to this Court's Protective Order.

The plaintiff will show this Court unimpeachable evidence that proves that earlier this month the defendant, continuing to resist and evade this Court's order, fraudulently procured a Protective Order from another Maricopa County Court to defeat this Court's order and continue blocking plaintiff's access to his Children. That the defendant had Detective Joya, with the Maricopa County Judicial Enforcement Unit, his phone number is 602-3765537, attempt to serve the plaintiff on several occasions.

The evidence will further show that the defendant abandoned her Children in March of 2023 and fled to Las Vegas, NV. The defendant procured an order of protection from the Avondale Court the end of December 2022, against the plaintiff and elected to have it dismissed prior to her abandoning her family in March of 2023.

The evidence will also show that at the same time this Court issued the protection order against the defendant this Court also issued a protective order against the Defendant's Sister whom the defendant at that time was living with in Las Vegas, NV.

The Public record evinces that the Sheriff in Las Vegas, NV, was able to serve the protection order on the Sister, but that the defendant was able to evade the Sheriff on at least 2-occasions.

The defendant did not send her Children anything or have anything to do with their lives from March 2023 to January 9, 2024. The plaintiff was their only security and provider. On January 9, 2024, as set-forth in the exhibits attached to this pleading, the plaintiff was rushed by ambulance to Boswell Hospital and taken into the ICU unit.

To the shock of the Children, not knowing their Father's full condition, the defendant's best friend and plaintiff's babysitter, Brittany Houston, forced the Children into the plaintiff's car and delivered them to the defendant. The defendant has completely blocked the plaintiff's access to the Children to this very day.

Not only must the defendant answer for grossly violating this Court's order, on many occasions, she must answer for violating the laws and statutes that are listed throughout the exhibits attached to this pleading. The defendant's criminal conduct satisfies the Custodial Interference, abandonment, child abuse, child neglect, interference with governmental functions, statutory requirements, and Fraud on this Court and the Court she used to circumvent this Court's order.

Wherefore the plaintiff is asking this Court to force the defendant to abide by its Protective Order, and return the Children to the plaintiff at once. The plaintiff further asks this Court to order the El Mirage Police and the Mesa, AZ Police, and the Maricopa County Sheriff, to Enforce this Court's Protective Order and the defendant's violations of that order, and to further enforce the AZ Laws And Statutes that the defendant has and or is violating.

ADDENDUM TO JANUARY 25, 2024 CERTIFIED CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

FEBRUARY 26, 2024

As of today, the 3-Minors that were kidnapped on January 9, 2024, have yet to be located.

On February 21, 2024, Mesa Police located and served the kidnapper Defendant Mother the Court Order, referred to herein and below, that prohibited her from approaching the 3-Children referred to herein and below.

A Partial List of Admissions made by El Mirage Police Chief and his Officers:

1. Since the day of the kidnapping, 1/9/2024, they knew of the Protective Order, issued by El Mirage Judge Parascandola on 4/6/2024, served by Mesa Police on 2/21/2024.
2. That they knew that the order prohibited the defendant Mother from approaching the 3-Children, 2-of-which are autistic.
3. That the order set-forth that the defendant has and or will commit physical harm.
4. That the babysitter defendant, Brittany Houston, listed herein and below, knew of the Protective Order and the danger to the Children, forced the Children into the Father's car and drove them to an unknown location and placed them into the Mother's custody.
5. That the babysitter had absolutely no authority or permission to take the Children out of the home for the purpose of transporting them to the Mother.
6. That the El Mirage Police arrested and incarcerated the babysitter on December 6, 2024, for assault and aggravated assault against a Surprise Elementary School Teacher and a 14-year-old student.
7. That the babysitter was wanted and facing 8-bench warrants for crimes against minors.
8. That the day of the kidnapping, 1/9/2024, the babysitter was on bond and awaiting trial for the crimes against minors.
9. That the babysitter refused to give the police or the Father the unknown location where she drop the Children off.
10. That on 1/10/2024, the Father procured a Protective Order from Judge Parascandola listing himself and his 3-Children as Plaintiffs and the babysitter as the defendant.
11. That during the 1/10.2024 hearing, the Father set-forth the threats of physical harm the babysitter made and the babysitters part in the kidnapping of his Children.
12. That the Chief ordered the officers to NOT get involved in the kidnapping. That the officers knew and or should of known where the defendant Mother was and that they were not to share her location.
13. That the Officers spoke to the defendant Mother on several occasions after the kidnapping.
14. That the defendant Mother had abandoned the Children for nine-and-a-half months, from March 2023 to January 9, 2024, and that she did not support the Children in any way shape or form during that period.
15. That the Defendant Mother had been committed to psychiatric wards on more than 5-occasions, complaining that she wanted to kill herself.

16. That in November of 2022, defendant Mother made 2-separate attempts to kill herself with the Children present.
17. That the defendant Mother refused to stop ingesting marijuana and breast feeding it to her baby, Marcel Stone, who is now faced with autism.
18. That on February 1, 2024, Mesa Police Officer Ryden, was dispatched to the defendant Mother's location and assured her that her location would be concealed from the Father.
19. That Officer Ryden knew of the Protective Order against defendant Mother and the fact that she was prohibited from coming near the Children.
20. That Officer Ryden used the phone to threaten the Father.
21. That Officer Ryden encouraged defendant Mother to continue evading the Protective Order and to approach a different Court and procure an order to continue blocking the Father's lawful access to the Children.
22. That the defendant Mother did in fact lie to the Court and procured an order against the Father to block his lawful access.
23. That a Maricopa County Sheriff's Detective made several attempts to serve the fraudulent order.
24. That on 1/9/2024, the Father was rushed to the Boswell Hospital ICU unit where his blood sugar was over 800 and his brain was swollen.
25. That the defendant Mother knew of the Protective Order prohibiting her from approaching the Children. That the Las Vegas, NV Sheriff made 2-attempts to serve her and that she "EVADED" service.
26. That the Defendant Mother's kidnapping the Children while the Father was in the ICU unit and her continuing conduct in blocking his access to the Children is being AIDED by El Mirage and Mesa Police, Mayors, and Others.

Please keep in mind that the statements herein are backed up by Court Records and other unimpeachable Records. That as a matter of law, the crimes, wrongs, civil and human rights deprivations, are "continuing".

On January 9, 2024, El Mirage Police responded to the Father's 911 call stating that he returned home, after being admitted to the ICU unit of Boswell Hospital earlier that day, and found his children missing. That he was told by the babysitter, that she transported the Children to an unknown location and gave them over to the Defendant Mother. The El Mirage Police had access to the Court record that evidenced the protective order prohibiting the Defendant from coming near the Children. The duty of the police at that time was to obtain from the babysitter the unknown drop-off location, find and rescue the Children and serve the Defendant Mother with the protective order and charge her with Custodial Interference/Kidnapping, Child Abandonment, Child Abuse, and other crimes.

It should be noted that on December 6, 2023, the babysitter, Brittany Houston, was arrested and incarcerated by the El Mirage Police for allegations of assault and aggravated assault of a Surprise Elementary Teacher and a minor. After the babysitter's incarceration the police found 8 bench warrants against her for crimes against Children.

On 1/9/2024, when El Mirage Police questioned the babysitter about Timothy's Children she was on bond regarding the bench warrants for crimes against Children.

On January 10, 2024, a hearing was held to procure a Protective Order against the babysitter for threats against Timothy and her part in taking his Children. During the hearing Timothy told Judge Parascandola that the babysitter, without his authority, transported his 3-Children to a unknown location and gave the Children to the Defendant-Mother. Judge Parascandola was the same judge that issued the April 6, 2023 Protective Order against the defendant-Mother to specifically protect the Children and Timothy from her.

On January 15, 2024, El Mirage Police finally responded to Timothy's 911 calls regarding his missing children. Timothy and his Father pleaded with the officers to find the Children. Timothy told the officers that it was possible that the defendant-Mother could be working in Mesa at Cubesmart. The officers actually pulled the protective order up on their patrol SUV computer and stated that it was their job to serve the protective order on the defendant and rescue the children. The officers told Timothy and the Children's Grandfather NOT to contact Mesa Police because they would take care of it. El Mirage Police never confirmed or denied that the defendant-Mother worked at Cubesmart.

On at least 2-different occasions, after 1/15/2024, the Defendant contacted the El Mirage Police, she was complaining that Timothy kept calling and pleading with her to return the Children. The Police actually called Timothy and told him to stop trying to find-out where the defendant and his Children were located.

The Defendant was encouraged by the Mesa and El Mirage Police to file a complaint with a Court, other than the El Mirage Court, and procure a Protective Order against the Husband to further EVADE the Protective Order issued against her on April 6, 2023, and to continue obstructing his access to the Children.

On February 1, 2024, the defendant-Mother contacted the Mesa Police Department and Officer Ryden, badge #23685, was dispatched to her location, the defendant-Mother procured Ryden's aid to talk to Timothy on the phone and threaten him with harassment if he did not stop trying to find her and his Children's location. During the conversation Timothy reminded Ryden that there is an active protective order against the defendant-Mother and she was prohibited from being near them. He told Officer Ryden that she continues to evade service and that she abandoned the Children for 9-months before kidnapping them on 1/9/2024. But Ryden refused to serve the protective order on her and rescue the Children.

MAJOR FRAUD, AND ABUSE OF PROCESS ON 2-COURTS

After encouragement from Mesa Police Officer Ryden, the defendant did in fact procure a protective order against Timothy. The Maricopa County Sheriff's Office actually made attempts to Serve the Defendant's Protective Order on Timothy. Keep in mind that the Maricopa County

Sheriff's Office had previously sent emails to Timothy stating that they had Timothy's Protective Order against the defendant and that she was evading service.

BACKGROUND

Court Case Arizona No. M0759P02023000017 evinces the issuance of the April 6, 2023, Protective Order, executed by AZ Judge Michael G. Parascandola in favor of 3-Minor Children and their Father, finding that the Defendant Mother, Sarea McCree, committed and or could commit "Physical Harm" to the Children and or Father.

The Judge "ORDERED" the El Mirage Police to immediately serve the Defendant. However, the Defendant elected to "ABANDON" Her family and she fled to Las Vegas, NV. The Defendant has been committed to the psychiatric ward of several hospitals/clinics, for observation regarding her repeated threats to get rid of her kids and kill herself. The Defendant's latest visit to a psychiatric ward, prior to fleeing AZ, was the entire week of November 19, 2022.

In December of 2022, the Defendant's Husband called 911 to report one of her violent psychotic episodes, which included, on two previous occasions, her gathering the family together while she swallowed enough pills to kill herself.

However, with previous knowledge of the Defendant's suicidal attempts, including a June 2022, episode they responded to, the Avondale Police elected to "FALSLEY" arrest the Husband and coerce him to plead guilty for "breaking" his own headphones. The Avondale Police left the vulnerable Children in the custody of the "UNSTABLE and Psychotic" Defendant.

After her Husband's arrest the Defendant, with the full aid of the Avondale Police, used the false police report to procure a protective order that prohibited her Husband and the Father of the 3-minors, from coming near them.

Keep in mind that after procuring a protective order against Timothy from the Avondale Court late December 2022, that the Defendant-Mother petitioned the Court to drop the Protective Order 3-months later, in March of 2023, and then she abandoned her Children and Timothy.

The WRONGS Complained of are still be committed by AZ State Officials with a DEPRAVED INDIFFERENCE to the lives and safety of the 3-MISSING BOYS and their Father. The acts were committed while the Father was in ICU for a few hours suffering from his type 1 diabetes attack and a slightly swollen brain. On 1/9/2024, at 2 A.M. he was taken by ambulance to Boswell Hospital and cleared to go home around 10 A.M. He returned home around 4 P.M. And found his 3-boys missing.

Please UNDERSTAND that the 3-MISSING BOYS are in harms-way. That the El Mirage Police knew and know that they have in their possession a Court Order that they were and still

are obligated to serve on the psychotic Mother that prohibits her from seeing the boys for fear of the boys safety. That the El Mirage Chief is not only obstructing access to the boys but is by his own acts and non-acts made himself, his department, the Mayor, Governor Hobbs and Others, accomplices to Child Endangerment, Child Abuse, Civil and Human Rights Violations, Kidnapping pursuant to Custodial Interference, and other crimes.

A copy of that Protective Order was and is filed with the Court and the El Mirage, AZ Police Department. As set-forth in the Certified Criminal Complaint of January 25, 2024, the defendant fled to Las Vegas, NV on or about March 22, 2023, with no-plans to return. A copy of the Protective Order was sent to the Las Vegas, NV Police. They made 2-attempts to serve the defendant and concluded that she was intentionally evading service.

On October, 10, 2023, a hearing was held in the Avondale City Court before Judge Sheri Rollison, Case No.:P02022000283. Timothy and his parents were present and the defendant was in Las Vegas and telephonically present. Judge Rollison asked the defendant how long she had been absent from her Children and she said over 6-months. Judge Rollison made it clear to the defendant that the Arizona law of "Abandonment" considers any parent that is absent for 6-months or more is subject to that law. Judge Rollison went on to say that the 3-Children and the decisions regarding them would be made and granted to Timothy.

It should be noted that from March 22, to January 9, 2024, during the Defendant's "Abandonment" of her children, that she did not send any support of any kind and made NO attempt to speak to her 2-autistic Children.
